Adjectives describe the noun (add information)

A black cat, a blue car

The French generally put any adjective AFTER the thing that they are speaking about.

Le chat noir, une voiture bleue.




Exceptions

A few adjectives are placed BEFORE the noun!

The easiest way to remember these is to use the

'BAGS' rule, words describing...

B - Beauty A - Age G - Good or Bad S - Size
